

Dear Students and Parents,

Central Driving School has recently outlined a "Trusted Safety Model" for our behind-the-wheel driving. These safety measures give us the confidence that we can re-open our driving school to our students. Our top priority is to stop the spread of COVID-19 and keep everyone safe.

Please take a few moments to read this letter, as this represents an important first step in resuming behind-the-wheel training.

Safety Measures include the following:

- Students and instructors will be required to wear a mask covering the nose/mouth but gloves are optional. Unfortunately, we will not be providing gloves or masks.
- Before each lesson, temperature screenings will be conducted on students and instructors.
- Instructors will be responsible for thoroughly cleaning the inside of the vehicle between students, using Lysol spray, wipes, alcohol etc.
- We will be circulating fresh air into the vehicle when possible. (ex. windows open)
- Students will need to meet instructor at Central Driving School. We are no longer providing at-home pickups at this time.
- **Please note, we are back logged due to COVID-19, and will be scheduling students as orderly and efficiently as possible.**
- **If you have questions or concerns unrelated to your teens driving schedule, feel free to reach out to us anytime!**
- **For the remainder of the year, our classroom hours will continue to be conducted online.**
- **Road tests and off-site testing are available, meaning you will not have to step foot into DMV in order to get the license. Please call us for more information!**
